



USING PUBLIC TRANSIT TO REACH GOLF HOUSE WEST FROM ORANGE COUNTY



Golf House West, the SCGA's headquarters, is easily accessible via the Metro Rail's Red Line Subway from most areas of Southern California.

Golf House West is a short par-4 hole away from the Universal City Red Line station. From the train platform, take two sets of escalators up, then turn

right and continue up the third set of escalators to the plaza. Walk south, under the Hollywood Freeway bridge. Turn left, cross the street, and continue 1/2 block to *Golf House West* (single-story brick building); the building entrance is in the rear.

BASIC RED LINE FACTS:

■ The Red Line runs from Union Station in downtown Los Angeles to North Hollywood, with a separate leg running to Wilshire Blvd. and Western Ave.

From any Red Line station except North Hollywood, Wilshire-Normandie or Wilshire-Western, take any train marked *North Hollywood* (not *Wilshire-Western*) and exit at the Universal City station. From the North Hollywood station, take any southbound train and get off at the next stop. From the Wilshire-Western or Wilshire-Normandie stations, take any eastbound train to the Wilshire-Vermont station, then take any northbound train marked *North Hollywood*.

■ Red Line trains run approximately every 10 minutes during rush hour and every 12-20 minutes otherwise. The trip from Union Station to Universal City is approximately 30 minutes.

■ The basic Metro Rail fare is \$1.25 but most people

buy a *Day Pass* for \$3. Senior (age 65 or older) or disabled fares are 45 cents (\$1.50 for a day pass).

Transfers from Metrolink trains are free with the purchase of a round-trip, 10-trip or monthly pass. There are no free transfers from the Blue, Gold, Green or Orange Lines or from Metro Rapid buses (that's why most people buy a *Day Pass*).

■ Tickets are sold at each Metro Rail station via machine — buy tickets before boarding the train. Select the fare required, insert the appropriate money (the machines make change) and take the printed ticket from the bottom of the machine. Tickets and *Day Passes* purchased on buses require exact change.

■ Metro Rail trains operate on the honor system. Keep your ticket (or *Day Pass*) and show it to an inspector if asked (it's a \$250 fine if you don't have a valid ticket or Metrolink transfer).

□ FROM ORANGE COUNTY:

Take any Metrolink or Amtrak train headed to Los Angeles Union Station. Follow the signs to the Metro Rail Red Line (two levels below where the trains come in) and take any train marked *North Hollywood* (not *Wilshire-Western*) to the Universal City station. Transfers to the Red Line are free for Metrolink passen-

gers but not for Amtrak passengers (who must pay the basic Red Line fare of \$1.25; buy a ticket at the Metro Rail ticket machines on the Red Line level). Ride time from Union Station to the Universal City station is approximately 30 minutes.
