He scored a double eagle at the 520-yard first hole after hitting a three iron for his second shot. He went on to win his division by making a 50-foot eagle putt on the 18th hole. A dual sport athlete, Matt says his golf is aided by the balance he employs while surfing. He was named CIF State MVP in the long board.

Add Albatross Dept.: **CARL TOUCHET** stroked a 400-yard wind-aided drive at CBC Port Hueneme's 500-yard 18th hole, then knocked a pitching wedge shot into the cup. At El Prado's Butterfield Stage Course, **LARRY YOUNG** holed out his three-wood shot from 235 yards at the 500-yard 18th hole for a two.
