IN THE MAKING

Pate wins third TOCC; women claim net events

On a course that played up to its original nickname, John Pate of The Valley Club could manage only an even-par 72 at Mission Viejo Country Club, but it was enough for him to capture his third SCGA Tournament of Club Champions (TOCC) crown.

Meanwhile, SCGA history was made as women captured both net flights. Cheryl Jones of Bear Mountain GC fired a net 67 at Shadowridge CC to claim the President's Flight by one shot, and minutes away at El Camino CC, Kristen Williams of Tree House GC shared first-place honors with Winston Samson of So. Cal. Player's Club. It was the first time that women had won or shared both of the flights.

When Mission Viejo CC opened 40 years ago, the Robert Trent Jones, Sr.-design was tabbed "Mission Impossible" and it lived up to that moniker for 120 low-handicap golfers this year.

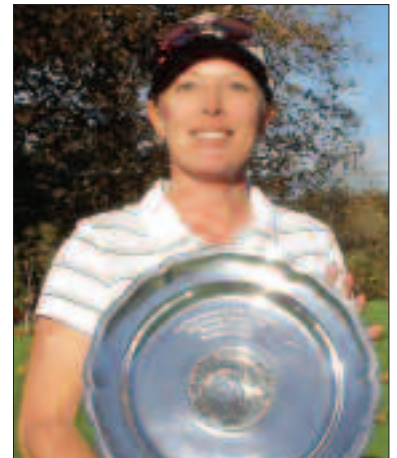
Pate, who also won this event in 2001 and 1987, posted four birdies, which was enough to overcome a double-bogey/bogey stretch on holes 7 and 8. He finished two shots in front of reigning California Amateur champion Don BuBois (Big Canyon) and Andrew Nelson (Arroyo Trabuco), who each carded 2-over-par 74s.

Further south, a thirty-minute frost delay couldn't chill the President's Flight at Shadowridge in Vista, as Jones took an uncontested first place finish.

Jones, the only woman in that field, fired a gross 83 from the 6,610-yard blue tees and recorded a net 67 to top opponents in her first SCGA tournament appearance. Her day was highlighted by a well-played 191-yard par 3 on hole 8, to

which she used her driver to sail the ball over a water hazard and hit the back of the green.

Other finishers included Arroyo Trabuco GC's Randy Cumming and San Diego Police Officers GC's Mike Mendez, who shot net 68s, and Granite Ridge GC's John Walsh and Boeing Space GC's Daniel Plascencia, whose back nine scores won a card-off that broke a five-way tie for fourth with a total nets of 71 apiece.

In Oceanside, Williams made waves as well, claiming a co-champion position with Samson by shooting a net 68 at El Camino. Williams was one of two women in the Vice President's flight.

Other winners at El Camino include Sal Martinez from Blue Skies G&CC, Randolph Rogers of Los Angeles Schools Valley GC and David Clement of River Ridge GC, who all tallied net 69s.

Multiple Winners: CHRIS VEITCH captured both the Santa Ana CC title and the one at the Citrus Course at La Quinta Resort & Club. WILL RITTER won at Oak Valley and Costa Mesa. RAY VANYO (a top-five finisher in the SCGA Senior Amateur in '05) won both the Mission Lakes and El Rancho Verde championships. BOB SUPPELSA captured Los Verdes' title and the Fore Score GC affiliate club's.
