The position will focus on administering the SCGA Junior donor database including donor acknowledgements, donor retention, reporting and donor communications. The position will do regular grant research on behalf of SCGA Junior and will support submission of grants and reporting requirements on a regular basis. The intern will also work closely with the SCGA Communications and Marketing team to include assisting with events and activities such as Dodger Night, Roger Dunn Night and PGA TOUR events. The intern will assist with community relation projects as they arise within both departments. This position will also support the expansion of all SCGA Junior programs and initiatives as well as serve as a representative for the SCGA and SCGA Junior to members, donors and the public by performing the duties as outlined below. To be successful in this position, the intern will have to be self-motivated, work well in a team, have an entrepreneurial spirit, and have the desire and passion to help SCGA Junior continue to grow.
