Training and experience with Titleist Performance Institute (TPI) Junior Golf Certification, LPGA and/or PGA is strongly preferred. Demonstrated passion for junior golf and positive youth development activities. Previous instruction work with youth ages 5-17 required. Previous playing experience preferred.
