- Ability to integrate diverse viewpoints, ideas and opinions working with staff, community and industry stakeholders.
- Must be willing to learn, be a good team member and bring a creative energy to the position.
- Proficient in using Microsoft Office.

Schedule and Pay:

The Program Manager is a full-time, exempt position. The work schedule will be Monday-Thursday and Saturday (Monday track off scheduling).
