





## EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S NOTE

As we continue to shape our mission, we have seen that our intentional, high-impact programming in underserved communities creates a difference for kids on and beyond the course. We've spent a significant portion of 2019 working with Claremont Graduate University doctoral research candidates to study our Southeast LA community and identify and quantify the ways that our program makes a difference – the magic of it if you will.

With CGU, we've been able to see that the magic lies within the community we create. We include kids, parents and stakeholders to foster an environment where everybody can grow together. As you've seen, we combine golf and nongolf activities to meet kids where they are and help them feel included at the course. This community that we create has a ripple effect that extends far beyond the course.

Sports don't inherently teach positive youth development. Our intentional programming creates impact and our properly trained coaches become role models who develop positive character traits in our kids. We're building community and changing kids' lives, not just as golfers, but also as people. This is why what we do is so important.

Our beneficial outcomes extend beyond technical golf skill and include social, emotional, relationship and cognitive-behavior skills. The program element that stands out for me is the coaches who constantly see the positive in everything the children do."

On average, parents reported seeing changes occur after 60 hours of program participation.

This year, we brought our Player & Youth Development Program to the San Fernando Valley and have hosted nearly 200 juniors for programming. We've developed relationships with local schools and organizations and are always looking for additional ways to grow. We hosted a series of Sunday Funday activities for this community that were fun, themed events that combined golf and nongolf activities. We are excited to see the success and impact of the PYD program, and our work with CGU will further improve our efforts.

As we move forward, we're even more excited to continue our growth and bring our programming to another region that needs our help. This year, we will be launching PYD programming in Riverside. We have identified Riverside as a community that is underserved in golf and we look forward to helping build a community of golfers.

Thanks to you, 2019 was a great year as we began the growth of our PYD program. 2020 is going to be even bigger and better for us as we continue to grow and expand.


