# SCGA 36-HOLE WOMEN'S STROKE PLAY CHAMPIONSHIP

# SATICOY COUNTRY CLUB MONDAY – TUESDAY, AUGUST 28 – 29

#### 1. ARRIVAL & REGISTRATION:

Upon arrival, all players should plan to drop their clubs off at Saticoy CC's bag drop. On Monday, all participants must check in at the SCGA registration table located in front of the Golf Shop.

#### 2. STARTING TIMES AND PAIRINGS:

Pairings for the first round will be e-mailed to players and posted online at <a href="scga.org/36hole">scga.org/36hole</a> one week in advance of the Championship. Starting times will range from 8 a.m. to approximately 10 a.m. both days off Hole 1. Pairings for round two will be available approximately one hour after the conclusion of round one.

#### 3. **PRACTICE ROUNDS:**

Players may make arrangements for practice rounds by calling the Saticoy Golf Shop at (805) 485-5216. The club is closed on Mondays. Green Fee: \$50, golf cart included.

# 4. **FORMAT:**

All participants will compete in a 36-hole stroke play championship (18 holes each day). The championship field will be divided into two flights based on Course Handicap. Awards will be given to the first and second place finishers in each flight for both gross and net. There will also be awards for the low gross over the field and low net over the field. All ties in all flights will be broken using the USGA method of matching score cards (Holes 10 - 18, etc., from the second round) with the exception of low gross over the field. In the event of a tie for low gross over the field, there will be a hole-by-hole playoff immediately following the conclusion of regular play.

# 5. **TEES:**

Play will be from the **SCGA** tee markers which will be placed near the gold yardages. Course Rating: 73.5 / Slope: 130 / Par 72 / 5,602 yards. (See p. 4 for anticipated hole-by-hole yardages).

#### 6. **DRIVING RANGE:**

The Driving Range will be open by 7 a.m. each day. Range balls will be provided compliments of Saticoy CC.

# 7. FOOD SERVICE AND PURCHASES:

The SCGA will host breakfast both days from 7 – 8:30 a.m. Lunch will be served on Tuesday for players only following the round. Players will be on their own for any other purchases. The snack bar will be open on Tuesday only for additional purchases. Only major credit cards will be accepted.

#### 9. **RULES OF PLAY:**

Play is governed by the *Rules of Golf*. Local Rules in effect will be found on the <u>SCGA Hard Card</u> and the Notice to Players addendum distributed at the site. Disregard all other club posted Local Rules including those on the back of the club's score card.

# 10. AUTOMOTIVE TRANSPORTATION / PULL CARTS & PUSH CARTS:

Golf carts are included as part of the entry fee. There will be a maximum of two carts per group and two bags per cart. Drivers must be at least 16 years of age (or older if club policy dictates). Each player is entitled to one seat in a cart. If a player brings a caddie, the caddie may ride provided there is a vacant seat in one of the carts. Otherwise, either the player or the caddie must walk.

# 11. DISTANCE MEASURING DEVICES AND CELL PHONES:

During the play of all SCGA competitions, a player may obtain distance information by use of a distance-measuring device. If, during a stipulated round, a player uses a distance-measuring device to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect his play (e.g. elevation changes, wind speed, etc.), the player is in breach of Rule 14-3. A multifunctional device, such as a smartphone or PDA, may be used as a distance-measuring device, but it must not be used to gauge or measure other conditions where doing so would be a breach of Rule 14-3. Any questions about such devices should be resolved before the start of the stipulated round. Otherwise, cell phone use is discouraged during the stipulated round.

## 12. CADDIES & SPECTATORS:

Players may provide their own caddie (See section 10 on Automotive Transportation). Caddies must adhere to the dress code listed in section 13 below. Spectators are permitted but are not allowed in carts. Spectators must adhere to all policies set forth by the club.

#### 13. **DRESS CODE:**

Members and guests may wear slacks, culottes, walking shorts or golf skirts. Denim may not be worn on the golf course or practice facilities. Sandals are permitted in the bar and dining rooms. Visors and hats are allowed on the golf course and bar area. Otherwise, visors and hats are restricted in the Formal Dining Room/Sun Room.

#### 14. PLAYER CODE OF CONDUCT:

By submitting an entry for any SCGA-administered competition, the contestant understands that his/her participation is at the sole discretion of the SCGA. A contestant may be removed from any competition at the discretion of the SCGA staff or Rules and Competitions Committee at any time before or during the competition. Incidents of unbecoming conduct or actions deemed to be detrimental to the image of the SCGA or the "Spirit of the Game" are grounds for such removal and suspension from future SCGA-administered competitions. These include, but are not limited to, the following:

- Willful damage of the golf course or golf course property
- Club throwing or unnecessary club tossing
- Offensive or unbecoming language
- Public criticism of golf course or verbal abuse of SCGA staff, officials, volunteers, host club staff or other contestants
- Potential endangerment of others
- Conduct deemed unbecoming
- Failure to post scores for handicapping purposes
- Manipulation of scores posted for handicapping purposes

## 15. **CANCELLATIONS**:

To withdraw for any reason prior to the start of an SCGA competition, a player must notify the SCGA Rules and Competitions Department at (818) 980-3630, or by clicking <a href="https://example.com/here">here</a>. If a player needs to withdraw on the morning of the event, notify the SCGA staff person through the golf shop staff at the host venue. Failure to notify the SCGA will subject the player to suspension from future SCGA competitions. Requests for refunds prior to the entry closing date will be honored less a \$10 administrative fee. Requests received after the entry closing date and 48 hours prior to the event will be honored less 50% of the entry fee. No refunds will be honored within 48 hours of the event.
