SHOTGUN ASSIGNMENTS

This is a significant event of great importance to the high school golfers. This is a “shotgun” start; hence we do not have starters to remind players on local rules and pace of play. Instead each SCGA rules official or staff will be the unofficial “starter” for each group at your assigned starting hole above. Please plan on arriving to your hole at 7:45 to be ready for the players arrival. You will be assigned a golf cart to ride out to your starting hole.

8:00 SHOTGUN START:

The players will shuttle (or walk) themselves out in carts to their assigned starting holes (players starting on holes 3-4-5-6 and 12-13-14-15 will ride out in golf carts, all other players will walk to the other starting holes). Please be stationed on the tee when the players arrive to do the following:

- 1) Each rules official/SCGA staff will ensure their Hole Location and tees are set up properly for their starting hole.
- 2) Make sure all the players have arrived.
- 3) Make sure the carts are parked in a non-intrusive area; the same players will take these carts back in when they are finished.
- 4) Distribute scorecards to each player; ensure they exchange scorecards with their fellow competitors.
- 5) Each player will be given a local rules sheet / hole location sheet at registration. You don't need to review the entire rules sheet with them however one item to point out is: **the flood control channel is a no play zone penalty area. Players should not enter or play a ball from within.**
- 6) Explain you will be the SCGA rules official on the course to assist them. If you can't assist them have them refer to the procedure on the back of their scorecard on how to play a second golf ball for a doubtful situation under Rule 20.1c.
- 7) Remind them to keep up with the group in front of them.
- 8) Remind them to return their scorecards to the scoring table immediately after the round.
- 9) Let them know when it is okay to play (make sure they are not teeing off when other players are still driving down their hole. You may announce each player to the tee when it is there turn to play). There is no air horn, please start them at 8:00 a.m. after Matt has completed a roll call.
- 10) SCGA live scoring stations will be situated on the course taking scores on the green of holes 2, 5, 9, 12, 15, & 18. Results available on scga.org/girlscif.
