2017 SCGA One-Day Series Match Play Champion

FORMAT

Single Elimination Match Play (Net)

TUESDAY, DECEMBER 11

- **ROUND OF 16:** Tee 1– 7:00 a.m. Tee Time start
- **QUARTERFINALS:** Tee 1– 12:00 p.m. Tee Time Start

WEDNESDAY, DECEMBER 12

- **SEMIFINALS:** Tee 1– 7:00 a.m. Tee Time start
- **FINALS:** Tee 1– 12:00 p.m. Tee Time Start

All players will play to their lowest Handicap Index from September 15th through December 1st (at 100% of their Course Handicap). The SCGA Rules & Competitions Committee reserves the right to adjust a player's course handicap at any time prior to or during the competition.



ENTRY FEE

The championship entry fee is \$150. In addition to the tournament rounds, cart fees, range balls and lunch on both days.

PAIRINGS

The official match play bracket and tee times will be available on the SCGA website at scga.org approximately one week prior to the championship.

In the event of a tie for any place on the One-Day Series Points List, the tie shall be broken based on;

1. Number of 2018 One-Day events participated in
2. Best finish in a 2018 One-Day event

CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS DISTRIBUTION

- Champion – 350 Points
- Runner-up – 250 Points
- Semifinals – 150 Points
- Quarterfinals – 100 Points
- Round of 16 – 50 Points

AWARDS & TIES

A match that ends all square at the conclusion of 18 holes will be played off hole-by-hole until one side wins a hole. The playoff will start on Hole 1 and continue until decided.

After the conclusion of the final match, awards will be issued to the Match Play Champion, the Runner up, and the 2018 Player of the Year.

One-Day Series Player of the Year - The Player of the Year award will be awarded to the participant with the highest point total after the Match Play Championship. (The winner of the Match Play Championship does not automatically win the Player of the Year.)

- One-Day Series Match Play Champion – Crystal trophy and a \$500 Roger Dunn Gift Card
- One-Day Series Match Play Runner-up – Pewter plate and a \$250 Roger Dunn Gift Card
- 2018 Player of the Year – Commemorative framed flag and a \$750 Roger Dunn Gift Card

PRACTICE ROUNDS – CONTESTANTS ONLY

Players may make arrangements for practice rounds at their own expense.

Green fees: \$99 before 12:00 p.m. and \$75 after 12:00 p.m.

Contact the The GC at Terra Lago at (760) 775-2000 to reserve a practice round. Please identify yourself as a SCGA One-Day Series Match Play participant.

Reservations will be issued on a first-come, first-served basis and all practice rounds will be issued at the sole discretion of the club. Players and caddies must adhere to the dress code in this document at all times.

TEES AND YARDAGES

A variety of yardages for men will be used throughout the championship. Please refer to the yardage guide below.

In general, all Men will play from the GOLD (Championship) yardages: approx. 6,289 yards / CR: 70.4 / Slope: 130 / Par 72.

In general, all Women will play from the RED (Forward) yardages: CR: approx. 5,240 yards / CR: 70.7 / Slope: 126 / Par 72.

DRIVING RANGE AND PRACTICE FACILITIES

The driving range and other practice facilities will be available starting at 6:30 a.m. each day of the championship.

FOOD AND BEVERAGE (PLAYERS ONLY)

The SCGA will be providing lunch for participants only on both tournament days.

FOOD AND BEVERAGE (CADDIES AND SPECTATORS)

Caddies and spectators may purchase food and beverage items at the snack bar. Cash and major credit cards will be accepted for all purchases.

SPECTATOR INFORMATION

All spectators must adhere to the dress code and cell phone policies listed in this document.

RULES OF PLAY

- Play is governed by the *Rules of Golf*.
- A Notice to Players addendum will be distributed at the championship site. Disregard all other club posted Local Rules including those on the back of the club's score card.

AUTOMOTIVE TRANSPORTATION / PULL CARTS

Golf carts are included as part of the entry fee and all contestants are encouraged to ride. Pull or push carts are permitted.

CADDIES

Players may provide their own caddie. All caddies must adhere to the dress code. Caddies will be issued an official caddie bib at the tee prior to each round which must be worn during the round and returned each day. Players bringing their own caddie are responsible for their conduct at all times while on the club's property.

DISTANCE-MEASURING DEVICES AND CELL PHONES

A player may obtain distance information by use of a distance-measuring device. If, during a stipulated round, a player uses a distance-measuring device to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect his play (e.g. elevation changes, wind speed, etc.), the player is in breach of Rule 14-3. A multi-functional device, such as a smartphone or PDA, may be used as a distance-measuring device, but it must not be used to gauge or measure other conditions where doing so would be a breach of Rule 14-3. Any questions about such devices should be resolved before the start of the stipulated round. Otherwise, cell phone use is discouraged during the stipulated round.

DRESS CODE

Players and caddies must be properly attired in golf shirts, slacks, Bermuda-length dress or golf shorts and soft spike shoes. Jeans (any color or any kind), T-shirts and tank tops will not be permitted. Shirts must be tucked in and hats are to be worn forward at all times.

REFUND POLICY:

Full Refund less \$10 processing fee if requested prior to closing date. 50% refund after the closing date and 48 hours prior to the event. No refunds will be honored within 48 hours of the event.

PACE OF PLAY POLICY

Match Play

Rule 6-7 of the Rules of Golf requires that a player “shall play without undue delay.” Notes 1 & 2 under Rule 6-7 are in effect.

Out of Position

The first group to start will be out of position if, at any time during the round, the group is behind the maximum allowable time to play.

Following groups will be considered out of position if, at any time during the round, the group is behind the maximum allowable time to play, and when approaching a tee, there is an open par-3 or par-4 hole or the preceding group is on the green of a par-5 hole.

Monitoring

- a. If a group is determined to be out of position at any time, the group will be advised that it is out of position and each player in the group will be monitored and timed.
- b. If any player in a group that is being monitored takes more than 40 seconds to play a stroke, the player will automatically incur the applicable penalty for breach of these guidelines.

Timing

- a. Timing shall begin when the player has had a reasonable opportunity to reach the ball, there is no interference from another person or ball, and it is the player’s turn to play.
- b. Any time spent walking backward or forward for measuring or other purposes will count as part of the time taken.
- c. On the putting green, a player will be allowed a reasonable time to lift, clean, and replace his ball, repair his ball mark, remove loose impediments and repair other ball marks on the player’s line of putt.
- d. When a group has regained its position, timing will be discontinued.
- e. In the event that the group is monitored later in the round, previous warnings and penalties will carry over.

Penalties

- 1st offense – warning
- 2nd offense – loss of hole
- 3rd offense – warning
- 4th offense – disqualification
