

## **SCHEDULE OF COMPETITIONS:**

- Regular Season: Group play may begin August 7 and must conclude by October 27
- SCGA Scratch League Wild Card Playoff: Oak Valley GC, November 7, 2019
- SCGA Scratch League Championship: Soule Park GC, November 15, 2019
- NCGA Scratch League Championship: Poppy Ridge, November 15, 2019
- California Scratch League Championship: Poppy Hills GC, December 6, 2019

**DEFINITION OF TEAM:** In 2019, Participating groups will have the option of determining how many professionals and how many amateurs will compete. Groups are allowed to play with as many (no maximum) or as few (no minimum) professionals and amateurs as they choose. This designation will be in place throughout the entirety of group play. Upon reaching the postseason, clubs will be required to play with 1 professional and 6 amateurs. A permanent roster is not required for each team. There is no limit as to the number of players who may be used during the season.

**Definition of an eligible Professional:** A member of the club's staff, including its teaching staff, who is not an amateur.

**Definition of an eligible Amateur:** An amateur golfer that is listed on the club's active GHIN ros-ter at the time of the club's first competition.
