PLEASE NOTE: WE ARE REQUESTING THAT YOU BRING THIS INFORMATION SHEET TO THE SITE WITH YOU ON THE DAY OF THE EVENT.

CONDITIONS OF THE COMPETITION

1. **STARTING TIMES:** Please check in with the starter at your assigned tee at least five to seven minutes in advance of your starting time. The starters will have information to discuss and distribute to each player in the group. Starters will not page players. Pairings for the final round will be based on the scores from the first round of play (leaders last). The pairings will be available approximately 1 hour after the conclusion of play on Monday.
2. **TEES:** Play will be from the **BLACK** tee markers. **BLUE** yardages will be used on Holes 5, 6, 7 and 14.

3. **FORMAT:** 36-holes of Four-Ball Stroke Play – 18 Holes played each day.
4. **RECORDING SCORES:** In Four-Ball competitions, only one partner must hole out. A partner who starts but does not complete a hole **must** record on the scorecard, for handicap purposes, the most likely score. The most likely score may not exceed the player's Equitable Stroke Control limit. This most likely score should be preceded by an "X" on the scorecard. Most likely score is a judgment that each player must make based on the player's own game. It consists of the number of strokes already taken plus, in the player's best judgment, the number of strokes needed to complete the hole from that position more than half the time. The player must evaluate each situation based on what the player can reasonable expect to score.
5. **RULES OF PLAY:**
 - *Play is governed by the USGA Rules of Golf.
 - *Local Rules in effect will be found on the enclosed SCGA Rules Hard Card and the Local Rules Addendum distributed at the site. Disregard all other club posted local rules.
 - *The "**one-ball**" rule will be in effect. During the entire stipulated round the balls a player plays must be of the same brand and type as detailed by a single entry on the current list of Conforming Golf Balls.
 - *Shoes with traditionally-designed spikes (regardless of composition, i.e., ceramic, plastic, etc.), regardless of design, comprised either entirely or partially of metal (when such metal comes in contact with the surface of the course) are prohibited. Penalty for breach of this condition: DISQUALIFICATION.
 - ***Distance measuring devices are permitted.**
 - *The use of cell phones will NOT be permitted during the round.
6. **TIES:** Awards will be given to the top five finishing teams. In the event of a tie for first place only, there will be a three-hole aggregate playoff immediately following the conclusion of regular play.
7. **AUTOMOTIVE TRANSPORTATION:**

Players and caddies are allowed to ride in carts (drivers have to be at least 16 years of age or older, if club policy dictates). Please note that a cart paths only restriction will be in effect. Spectators are not allowed in carts at any time. There will be a maximum of two carts per group and two bags per cart.
Cart rental fee: \$20 per cart (player's responsibility).
8. **PULL CARTS:** Pull carts are NOT permitted.
9. **CADDIES:** Players may bring a caddie. However, there will only be two carts per group allowed on the course.
10. **ATTIRE:**

PLAYERS, CADDIES and SPECTATORS must be properly attired in golf shirts, slacks, appropriate shorts and "spikeless" shoes. Jeans (any color or any kind), sweatpants, T-shirts and tank tops will not be permitted on the property. Hats must be worn forward at all times. Under no circumstances will this attire prohibition be waived. **ALL CLOTHING MUST BE IN GOOD REPAIR.**
11. **PLAYER CODE OF CONDUCT:**

By submitting an entry for any SCGA-administered competition, the contestant understands that his/her participation is at the sole discretion of the SCGA. A contestant may be removed from any competition at the discretion of the SCGA staff

or Rules and Competitions Committee at any time before or during the competition. Incidents of unbecoming conduct or actions deemed to be detrimental to the image of the SCGA or the "Spirit of the Game" are grounds for such removal and suspension from future SCGA-administered competitions. These include, but are not limited to the following:

- 1) Willful damage of the golf course or golf course property
- 2) Club throwing or unnecessary club tossing
- 3) Offensive or unbecoming language
- 4) Public criticism of golf course or verbal abuse of SCGA staff, officials, volunteers, host club staff or other contestants
- 5) Potential endangerment of others
- 6) Conduct deemed unbecoming

12. **CANCELLATIONS :**

To withdraw for any reason prior to the start of an SCGA competition, a player must notify the SCGA Rules and Competitions Department at (818) 432-4169. Failure to notify the SCGA will subject the player to suspension from future SCGA competitions. A player who only contacts the course and not the SCGA will be subject to the suspension. If you plan to withdraw please contact the SCGA office as soon as possible so an alternate can be contacted to play.

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. **REGISTRATION:** All players must check in on Monday at the SCGA registration table located in the breezeway (adjacent to the practice putting green / clubhouse).
2. **PRACTICE ROUNDS:** Players may contact the Industry Hills Golf Shop in advance to arrange a practice round.
 - *The golf course will be closed until November 2 for overseeding.
 - *Players should identify themselves as a participant in the SCGA Four-Ball Championship to receive member rates.
 - *Fee: \$65 on Friday, \$82 on Saturday and Sunday. Reduced twilight rates are available.
 - *Cart Fee: Included. Please note that a cart paths only restriction will be in effect.
3. **DRIVING RANGE:** The driving range will open at 6:00 a.m. The driving range is located across the road from the parking lot.
 - *Driving Range Fee: \$5 for 80 balls.
4. **LOCKER ROOM:** Locker Room service will not be available – players are advised to come dressed and ready to play.
5. **FOOD SERVICE:** St. Andrews Station will be open at 6:30 a.m. each day. There is also a concession stand located outside the Golf Shop (cash only).
 - *The SCGA will host breakfast on Monday and Tuesday on the patio adjacent to the Golf Shop (6:30 a.m. – 10:00 a.m.).
 - *The SCGA will host lunch at St. Andrews Station immediately following the conclusion of play on Monday.
6. **CASH PURCHASES:**
 - * Cash will be accepted. There is an ATM in the resort lobby.
 - * Major credit cards will be accepted.
 - *Reciprocal Chits will not be accepted.
