CONDITIONS OF THE COMPETITION

1. STARTING TIMES: Please check in with the starter at your assigned tee at least five to seven minutes in advance of your tee time. The starters will have information to discuss and distribute to each player in the group. Starters will not page players.
2. TEES: Play will be from the **BLUE** tee markers. (72.0/ 132/ 6,566 yards)
3. FORMAT: 36-hole qualifying round. Qualifiers advance to U.S. Junior Amateur Championship to be held at Boone Valley Golf Club in Augusta, Missouri on July 23-28, 2007. Final number of qualifying spots will be available from the Committee on the day of play.
4. RULES OF PLAY:
 - ◆ Play is governed by the USGA Rules of Golf.
 - ◆ Local Rules in effect will be found on the enclosed USGA Rules Hard Card and the Local Rules Addendum distributed at the site. Disregard all other club posted local rules.
 - ◆ The "**one-ball**" rule will be in effect. During the entire stipulated round the balls a player plays must be of the same brand and type as detailed by a single entry on the current list of Conforming Golf Balls.
 - ◆ Shoes with traditionally-designed spikes (regardless of composition, i.e., ceramic, plastic, etc.), regardless of design, comprised either entirely or partially of metal (when such metal comes in contact with the surface of the course) are prohibited. Penalty for breach of this condition: DISQUALIFICATION.
 - ◆ **Distance measuring devices are NOT permitted.**
 - ◆ The use of cell phones will NOT be permitted at the club or during the round.
5. TIES: In the event of a tie for the last qualifying place or an alternate's position, there will be a sudden-death playoff immediately following the conclusion of regular play.
6. AUTOMOTIVE TRANSPORTATION:
It is USGA policy that players and caddies are not allowed to ride in carts. Spectators are not allowed in carts at any time.
7. PULL CARTS:
Pull carts are permitted. Club does not rent pull carts.
8. CADDIES: Player may bring caddie; However, a player may not use a parent, step parent, or guardian as a caddie during Sectional Qualifying or the Championship proper.
9. PLAYER CODE OF CONDUCT:
By submitting an entry for any SCGA-administered competition, the contestant understands that his/her participation is at the sole discretion of the SCGA. A contestant may be removed from any competition at the discretion of the SCGA staff or Rules and Competitions Committee at any time before or during the competition. Incidents of unbecoming conduct or actions deemed to be detrimental to the image of the SCGA or the "Spirit of the Game" are grounds for such removal and suspension from future SCGA-administered competitions. These include, but are not limited to the following:
 - 1) Willful damage of the golf course or golf course property
 - 2) Club throwing or unnecessary club tossing
 - 3) Offensive or unbecoming language
 - 4) Public criticism of golf course or verbal abuse of SCGA staff, officials, volunteers, host club staff or other contestants
 - 5) Potential endangerment of others
 - 6) Conduct deemed unbecoming

10. ATTIRE:
PLAYERS, CADDIES and SPECTATORS must be properly attired in golf shirts, slacks or (bermuda-length dress shorts) and "spikeless" shoes. NO CARGO SHORTS OR SHORTS WITH EXTERNAL POCKETS. Jeans (any color or any kind), sweatpants, T-shirts and tank tops will not be permitted during any phase of the competition. Shirts must be tucked in and hats are to be worn forward at all times. Under no circumstances will this attire prohibition be waived for players.
 ALL CLOTHING MUST BE IN GOOD REPAIR.
11. CANCELLATIONS :
 To withdraw for any reason prior to the start of an USGA competition, a player must notify the SCGA Rules and Competitions Department at (818) 432-4169 and the USGA Championship Administration Department at (908) 234-2300.

1. PRACTICE ROUNDS:
 Players may make arrangements for practice rounds at their own expense. Practice rounds are for participants only. Fee: \$15 per player. Contact the Golf Shop at (951) 274-7906 to schedule a practice round. There is no guarantee a desired practice round time will be available. Please call in advance to schedule.
2. DRIVING RANGE:
 Driving range opens at 6:00 a.m.
 Balls will be available on the range, compliments of Canyon Crest Country Club.
3. LOCKER ROOM:
 Not available, players are to come dressed ready to play.
4. FOOD SERVICE:
 A limited breakfast will be available in the restaurant starting at 6:00 a.m. Lunch will be available in between rounds in the restaurant.
5. CASH PURCHASES:
 Cash will be accepted for all purchases.
