CONDITIONS OF THE COMPETITION

1. **STARTING TIMES:** Please check in with the starter at your assigned tee at least five to seven minutes in advance of your tee time. The starters will have information to discuss and distribute to each player in the group. Starters will not page players.
2. **TEES:** Play will be from the **BLACK** tee markers (72.9 / 134 / 6,803).
3. **FORMAT:** 36-hole qualifying round. Qualifiers advance to the 107th U.S. Amateur Championship to be held at The Olympic Club on August 20-26, 2007. Final number of qualifying spots will be available from the Committee on the day of play.
4. **RULES OF PLAY:**
 - *Play is governed by the USGA Rules of Golf.
 - *Local Rules in effect will be found on the enclosed USGA Rules Hard Card and the Local Rules Addendum distributed at the site. Disregard all other club posted local rules.
 - *The "**one-ball**" rule will be in effect. During the entire stipulated round the balls a player plays must be of the same brand and type as detailed by a single entry on the current list of Conforming Golf Balls.
 - ***Distance measuring devices are NOT permitted.**
 - *The use of cell phones, pagers, blackberries or any portable phones will NOT be permitted at the club or during the round.
5. **TIES:** In the event of a tie for the last qualifying place or an alternate's position, there will be a sudden-death playoff immediately following the conclusion of regular play.
6. **AUTOMOTIVE TRANSPORTATION:**

Carts will not be permitted for players or caddies. Spectators are not allowed in carts at any time.
7. **PULL CARTS:** Pull carts are permitted. The club does not have any for rent.
8. **CADDIES:** Player may bring caddie. Caddies must adhere to the dress code.
9. **PLAYER CODE OF CONDUCT:**

By submitting an entry for any SCGA-administered competition, the contestant understands that his/her participation is at the sole discretion of the SCGA. A contestant may be removed from any competition at the discretion of the SCGA staff or Rules and Competitions Committee at any time before or during the competition. Incidents of unbecoming conduct or actions deemed to be detrimental to the image of the SCGA or the "Spirit of the Game" are grounds for such removal and suspension from future SCGA-administered competitions. These include, but are not limited to the following:

 - 1) Willful damage of the golf course or golf course property
 - 2) Club throwing or unnecessary club tossing
 - 3) Offensive or unbecoming language
 - 4) Public criticism of golf course or verbal abuse of SCGA staff, officials, volunteers, host club staff or other contestants
 - 5) Potential endangerment of others
 - 6) Conduct deemed unbecoming
10. **ATTIRE:**

PLAYERS, CADDIES and SPECTATORS must be properly attired in golf shirts, slacks or (Bermuda-length dress shorts) and "spikeless" shoes. Jeans (any color or any kind), sweatpants, T-shirts and tank tops will not be permitted during any phase of the competition. Under no circumstances will this attire prohibition be waived for players. Hats are to be worn forward at all times. ALL CLOTHING MUST BE IN GOOD REPAIR.

11. CANCELLATIONS:
To withdraw for any reason prior to the start of an USGA competition, a player must notify the SCGA Rules and Competitions Department at (818) 432-4169 **and** the USGA Championship Administration Department at (908) 234-2300.

1. PRACTICE ROUNDS:
Players may make arrangements for practice rounds at their own expense.
Practice rounds will be available any day on a space available basis.
Fee: \$30; Cart Fee: \$17. Identify yourself as a participant in the qualifier to obtain these rates.
Please call the Cypress Ridge Golf Shop as early as possible to make arrangements.

2. DRIVING RANGE:
Driving range opens at 7:00 a.m.
Balls will be available on the range, compliments of Cypress Ridge Golf Course.

3. LOCKER ROOM:
Players are to arrive dressed and ready to play – a locker room will not be available.

4. FOOD SERVICE:
The Grill will be open from 7:00 a.m. until the conclusion of play.

*We are expecting a short break in between rounds. Therefore, box lunches will be available for purchase near your afternoon starting hole.

Reciprocal chits will not be accepted.
