PLEASE NOTE: WE ARE REQUESTING THAT YOU BRING THIS INFORMATION SHEET TO THE SITE WITH YOU ON THE DAY OF THE EVENT.

CONDITIONS OF THE COMPETITION

1. **STARTING TIMES:** Please check in with the starter at your assigned tee at least five to seven minutes in advance of your tee time. The starters will have information to discuss and distribute to each player in the group. Starters will not page players.
2. **TEES:** Play will be from the **BLUE** tee markers. (71.9 / 131 / 6,576 yards)
3. **FORMAT:** One 18-hole stroke play qualifying round. Qualifying for the Senior and Super Senior Championships will be held simultaneously at the qualifying sites. All participants will play from the same tees. There will be two separate tournaments: all players between the age of 55-64 will play in the Senior Flight and all players over the age of 65 will play in the Super Senior Flight. Super Seniors are also eligible for the overall Senior Championship title.
4. **RULES OF PLAY:**
 - *Play is governed by the USGA Rules of Golf.
 - *Local Rules in effect will be found on the enclosed SCGA Rules Hard Card and the Local Rules Addendum distributed at the site. Disregard all other club posted local rules.
 - *The "**one-ball**" rule will be in effect. During the entire stipulated round the balls a player plays must be of the same brand and type as detailed by a single entry on the current list of Conforming Golf Balls.
 - *Shoes with traditionally-designed spikes (regardless of composition, i.e., ceramic, plastic, etc.), regardless of design, comprised either entirely or partially of metal (when such metal comes in contact with the surface of the course) are prohibited. Penalty for breach of this condition: DISQUALIFICATION.
 - ***Distance measuring devices are permitted.**
 - *The use of cell phones will NOT be permitted during the round.
5. **TIES:** In the event of a tie for the last qualifying place or an alternate's position, there will be a sudden-death playoff immediately following the conclusion of regular play.
6. **AUTOMOTIVE TRANSPORTATION:**

Carts are optional. Players and caddies are allowed to ride in carts (drivers have to be at least 16 years of age or older, if club policy dictates). Spectators are not allowed in carts at any time. There will be a maximum of 2 carts per group and 2 bags per cart. Cart rental fee: \$13.50 per player (player's responsibility).
7. **PULL CARTS:**

Pull carts are permitted. Club does not rent pull carts.
8. **CADDIES:** Player may bring caddie.
9. **PLAYER CODE OF CONDUCT:**

By submitting an entry for any SCGA-administered competition, the contestant understands that his/her participation is at the sole discretion of the SCGA. A contestant may be removed from any competition at the discretion of the SCGA staff or Rules and Competitions Committee at any time before or during the competition. Incidents of unbecoming conduct or actions deemed to be detrimental to the image of the SCGA or the "Spirit of the Game" are grounds for such removal and suspension from future SCGA-administered competitions. These include, but are not limited to the following:

 - 1) Willful damage of the golf course or golf course property
 - 2) Club throwing or unnecessary club tossing
 - 3) Offensive or unbecoming language
 - 4) Public criticism of golf course or verbal abuse of SCGA staff, officials, volunteers, host club staff or other contestants

- 5) Potential endangerment of others
- 6) Conduct deemed unbecoming

10. ATTIRE:
PLAYERS, CADDIES and SPECTATORS must be properly attired in golf shirts, slacks or (bermuda-length dress shorts) and "spikeless" shoes. Jeans (any color or any kind), denim, cut off shorts, sweatpants, T-shirts and tank tops will not be permitted during any phase of the competition. Hats are to be worn forward at all times. Shirts must be tucked in. Under no circumstances will this attire prohibition be waived for players. **ALL CLOTHING MUST BE IN GOOD REPAIR.**
11. CANCELLATIONS :
To withdraw for any reason prior to the start of an SCGA competition, a player must notify the SCGA Rules and Competitions Department at (818) 432-4169. Failure to notify the SCGA will subject the player to suspension from future SCGA competitions. A player who only contacts the course and not the SCGA will be subject to the suspension.

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. PRACTICE ROUNDS:
Players may make arrangements for practice rounds at their own expense.

Fee: \$40, including cart. Caddies may play also.
2. DRIVING RANGE:
The Carlsbad Golf Center (located across Hwy. 78 from El Camino CC at 2711 Haymar Drive, Carlsbad 92010) will have a full driving range available for player use, starting at 6:30 a.m.
A hitting net will also be available at El Camino CC, with range balls compliments of the club.
3. LOCKER ROOM:
Locker room will not be available. Players are advised to arrive dressed and ready to play.
4. FOOD SERVICE:
Food service will be available at the Clubhouse restaurant from 6:30 a.m. until the conclusion of play.
5. CASH PURCHASES:
Cash will be accepted for all purchases.
Reciprocal chits will **not** be accepted.
Major credit cards will be accepted.
