PLEASE NOTE: WE ARE REQUESTING THAT YOU BRING THIS INFORMATION SHEET TO THE SITE WITH YOU ON THE DAY OF THE EVENT.

CONDITIONS OF THE COMPETITION

1. **STARTING TIMES:** Please check in with the starter at your assigned tee at least five to seven minutes in advance of your tee time. The starters will have information to discuss and distribute to each player in the group. Starters will not page players. Pairings for the final round will be based on the scores from the first round of play. The pairings will be available approximately 1 hour after the conclusion of play on Monday.
2. **TEES:** Play will be from the **Blue** tee markers (73.4 / 139 / Approx. 6550 - 6600 yards).
3. **FORMAT:** 36-hole championship, 18 holes played each day. There are two separate championships being run concurrently, Senior (55 and above) and Super Senior (65 and above). All players are eligible to win the Senior Championship. The low scoring senior over the age of 65 will win the Super Senior Championship.
4. **RULES OF PLAY:**
 - ◆ Play is governed by the USGA Rules of Golf.
 - ◆ Local Rules in effect will be found on the enclosed SCGA Rules Hard Card and the Local Rules Addendum distributed at the site. Disregard all other club posted local rules.
 - ◆ The "**one-ball**" rule will be in effect. During the entire stipulated round the balls a player plays must be of the same brand and type as detailed by a single entry on the current list of Conforming Golf Balls.
 - ◆ Shoes with traditionally-designed spikes (regardless of composition, i.e., ceramic, plastic, etc.), regardless of design, comprised either entirely or partially of metal (when such metal comes in contact with the surface of the course) are prohibited. Penalty for breach of this condition: DISQUALIFICATION.
 - ◆ **Distance measuring devices are permitted.**
 - ◆ The use of cell phones will NOT be permitted during the round or in the clubhouse.
5. **TIES:** Awards will be given to the top 5 finishers. In the event of a tie for overall 1st place only, there will be a 3 hole aggregate playoff immediately following the conclusion of regular play.
Super Seniors: Awards will be given to the top 3 finishers. Ties in the Super Senior Division will be decided by a sudden death playoff.
6. **AUTOMOTIVE TRANSPORTATION:**
Carts are optional. Players and caddies are allowed to ride in carts. Spectators are not allowed in carts at any time. There will be a maximum of 2 carts per group and 2 bags per cart. If only two players in a group are riding they may be required to join in the same cart.
7. **PULL CARTS:** Pull carts are permitted. Club does not rent pull carts.
8. **CADDIES:** Players may bring their own caddie. Hacienda Golf Club has a limited number of caddies available. Contact the club to reserve a caddie at (562) 697-3610.
9. **PLAYER CODE OF CONDUCT:**
By submitting an entry for any SCGA-administered competition, the contestant understands that his/her participation is at the sole discretion of the SCGA. A contestant may be removed from any competition at the discretion of the SCGA staff or Rules and Competitions Committee at any time before or during the competition. Incidents of unbecoming conduct or actions deemed to be detrimental to the image of the SCGA or the "Spirit of the Game" are grounds for such removal and suspension from future SCGA-administered competitions. These include, but are not limited to the following:
 - 1) Willful damage of the golf course or golf course property
 - 2) Club throwing or unnecessary club tossing
 - 3) Offensive or unbecoming language
 - 4) Public criticism of golf course or verbal abuse of SCGA staff, officials, volunteers, host club staff or other contestants

- 5) Potential endangerment of others
- 6) Conduct deemed unbecoming

10. ATTIRE:
PLAYERS, CADDIES and SPECTATORS must be properly attired in golf shirts (mock turtlenecks must be 1.5" or higher), slacks, appropriate shorts and "spikeless" shoes. Shorts must be traditional and conservative with no oversized pocket or pockets sewn on the outside (**No Cargo Shorts**). Shorts must be no longer than below the kneecap and no shorter than 4" above the middle of the knee. Jeans (any color or any kind), cargo shorts, sweatpants, T-shirts and tank tops will not be permitted on the property. Shirts must be tucked in and caps must be worn forward and are not allowed to be worn in the clubhouse. Under no circumstances will this attire prohibition be waived. Players, caddies and spectators not in appropriate attire will be asked to leave or purchase appropriate attire in the golf shop. ALL CLOTHING MUST BE IN GOOD REPAIR.
11. CANCELLATIONS :
To withdraw for any reason prior to the start of an SCGA competition, a player must notify the SCGA Rules and Competitions Department at (818) 432-4169. Failure to notify the SCGA will subject the player to suspension from future SCGA competitions. A player who only contacts the course and not the SCGA will be subject to the suspension. If you plan to withdraw please contact the SCGA office as soon as possible so an alternate can be contacted to play.

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. REGISTRATION: All players must register at the SCGA registration table located next to the parking lot upon arrival on Monday.
2. PRACTICE ROUNDS: Practice rounds will be issued by the club on a space available basis at the club's discretion.
*Contact the golf shop to reserve a practice round tee time.
*Fee: Weekday: \$35 / Weekend: \$42.50 (Cash or reciprocal charges only).
3. DRIVING RANGE: The driving range will be open at 7:00 am.
*Range balls will be available on the range and are compliments of Hacienda Golf Club.
* The range is limited in distance (approx. 235 yards). Players will be prohibited from using drivers if they can hit range balls over the protective net.
4. LOCKER ROOM: Full locker room service will be available. Each player will be issued a locker number at the registration table. Locker room will open at 7:00 a.m. Players must change shoes in the locker room.
5. FOOD SERVICE:
* Complimentary buffet breakfast will be hosted by the SCGA each day for players. Available 7:30 a.m. - 10:00 a.m.
* Lunch will be hosted by the SCGA each day for players. Available 12:30 p.m. – 3:30 p.m.
* Snack Bar will be available and ready for cash purchases each day. Snack Bar is located at the 10th tee.
6. CASH PURCHASES:
* Cash will be accepted.
* Reciprocal chits will be accepted.
* Major credit cards will not be accepted.
