CONDITIONS OF THE COMPETITION

1. **STARTING TIME:** 8:00 a.m. shotgun start, Monday and Tuesday.
2. **TEES:** Play will be from the **Black** tee markers for men (71.9 / 128 / 6,502 yards) and the **Silver** tee markers for women (74.0 / 134 / 5,632 yards).
3. **FORMAT:** 36-hole championship. All players will play 18 holes on Monday and 18 holes on Tuesday.

Round 1: Four-Ball (two-person better ball). Each individual will play to 90% (men) and 95% (women) of their course handicap. If partners' course handicaps differ by more than 8 strokes, an additional 10% reduction will be applied to their course handicaps.

Round 2: Pinehurst format. Each partner drives from each tee, then plays the second shot with the other's ball. After the second shots, the team selects which ball it wishes to score with, and plays that ball alternately to complete the hole. The player with the lower course handicap is allowed 60% of his/her course handicap. The player with the higher course handicap is allowed 40% of his/her course handicap. The total of both partners' course handicaps is deducted from team score at the end of the round.
4. **RULES OF PLAY:**
 - ◆ Play is governed by the USGA Rules of Golf.
 - ◆ Local Rules in effect will be found on the enclosed SCGA Rules Hard Card and the Local Rules Addendum distributed at the site. Disregard all other club posted local rules.
 - ◆ The "one-ball" rule will not be in effect.
 - ◆ Shoes with traditionally-designed spikes (regardless of composition, i.e., ceramic, plastic, etc.), regardless of design, comprised either entirely or partially of metal (when such metal comes in contact with the surface of the course) are prohibited. Penalty for breach of this condition: DISQUALIFICATION.
 - ◆ **Distance measuring devices are permitted.**
 - ◆ The use of cell phones will NOT be permitted during the round or in the clubhouse.
5. **TIES:** Awards will be distributed to the five teams with the low, two-day net totals. In the event of a tie for 1st place, co-champions will be declared. Ties for 2nd through 5th places will be broken by matching scorecards (based on holes #10-#18 on Day 2) as recommended by the USGA.
6. **AUTOMOTIVE TRANSPORTATION:**
Players and caddies are allowed to ride in carts (drivers have to be at least 16 years of age or older, if club policy dictates). Spectators are not allowed in carts at any time. There will be a maximum of 2 carts per group and 2 bags per cart. Cart rental: Included.
7. **PULL CARTS:** Pull carts are permitted. Club does not rent pull carts.
8. **CADDIES:** Player may bring a caddie.
9. **PLAYER CODE OF CONDUCT:**
By submitting an entry for any SCGA-administered competition, the contestant understands that his/her participation is at the sole discretion of the SCGA. A contestant may be removed from any competition at the discretion of the SCGA staff or Rules and Competitions Committee at any time before or during the competition. Incidents of unbecoming conduct or actions deemed to be detrimental to the image of the SCGA or the "Spirit of the Game" are grounds for such removal and suspension from future SCGA-administered competitions. These include, but are not limited to the following:
 - 1) Willful damage of the golf course or golf course property
 - 2) Club throwing or unnecessary club tossing
 - 3) Offensive or unbecoming language
 - 4) Public criticism of golf course or verbal abuse of SCGA staff, officials, volunteers, host club staff or other contestants
 - 5) Potential endangerment of others

- 6) Conduct deemed unbecoming
10. ATTIRE:
PLAYERS, CADDIES and SPECTATORS must be properly attired in golf shirts, slacks or (bermuda-length dress shorts) and "spikeless" shoes. Jeans (any color or any kind), sweatpants, T-shirts and tank tops will not be permitted during any phase of the competition. Caps must be worn forward. Under no circumstances will this attire prohibition be waived for players. ALL CLOTHING MUST BE IN GOOD REPAIR.
11. CANCELLATIONS :
To withdraw for any reason prior to the start of an SCGA competition, a player must notify the SCGA Rules and Competitions Department at (818) 432-4169. Failure to notify the SCGA will subject the player to suspension from future SCGA competitions. A player who only contacts the course and not the SCGA will be subject to the suspension.

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. REGISTRATION: All players must check in at the registration table located adjacent to the clubhouse upon arrival to the course on Monday morning.
2. PRACTICE ROUNDS:
*Contact the Golf Shop at (760) 731-6803 to schedule a practice round.
*Member rates apply (mention you are playing in the Championship): \$45 Monday – Friday, \$60 Saturday - Sunday.
*Carts are included.
3. DRIVING RANGE:
*The driving range will be open at 6:00 am.
*Range balls will be available on the range and are compliments of Pala Mesa Resort and the SCGA.
4. LOCKER ROOM:
*There will not be a locker room available. Players are advised to come dressed and ready to play.
5. FOOD SERVICE:
* Breakfast will be available for purchase each day for players, available at 6:30 a.m. in the Restaurant.
* Lunch will be available for purchase in the Restaurant on Monday.
* The SCGA will host a luncheon following the conclusion of play on Tuesday.
* Players may purchase food items from the Snack Bar, located across from the Golf Shop, from 6:30 a.m. - 5:00 p.m.
6. CASH PURCHASES:
* Cash will be accepted.
* Reciprocal chits will not be accepted.
* Major credit cards will be accepted.
7. LODGING ALTERNATIVES:
A special rate of \$125 per room has been secured for tournament participants. Call the Resort for reservations and mention "SCGA."
