CONDITIONS OF THE COMPETITION

1. **STARTING TIMES:** Please check in with the starter at your assigned tee at least five to seven minutes in advance of your tee time. The starters will have information to discuss and distribute to each player in the group. Starters will not page players.
2. **TEES:**
VICE PRESIDENT FLIGHT: BLUE tee markers (but WHITE yardages will be used). 70.6 / 115 / 6449 yards
TREASURER FLIGHT: WHITE tee markers (SILVER yardages will be used on Holes 4, 6, 9, 10, 12, 16 and 18). 69.3 / 112 / 6168 yards
3. **FORMAT:** 36-holes (18 each day) stroke play. The field is divided into flights based on your lowest index of the last three months: President (7.4 and below), Vice-President (7.5-12.4), Secretary (12.5-18.4) and Treasurer (18.5 and above). All players will play to their lowest index of the last three months (May – July).
***NOTE: Pairings will be e-mailed to you and available at www.scga.org on July 2. The reason for the delay is so that your July index can be used to determine what handicap you will play to at the championship.**
4. **RULES OF PLAY:**
 - ◆ Play is governed by the USGA Rules of Golf.
 - ◆ Local Rules in effect will be found on the enclosed SCGA Rules Hard Card and the Local Rules Addendum distributed at the site. Disregard all other club posted local rules.
 - ◆ The "one-ball" rule will NOT be in effect.
 - ◆ Shoes with traditionally-designed spikes (regardless of composition, i.e., ceramic, plastic, etc.), regardless of design, comprised either entirely or partially of metal (when such metal comes in contact with the surface of the course) are prohibited. Penalty for breach of this condition: DISQUALIFICATION.
 - ◆ **Distance measuring devices are permitted.**
 - ◆ The use of cell phones will NOT be permitted during the round.
5. **TIES:** In the event of a tie for the last qualifying place or an alternate's position, the USGA method of matching scorecards will be used to determine results using Holes 10-18. (See Appendix I: Conditions of the Competition in the USGA Rules of Golf).
6. **AUTOMOTIVE TRANSPORTATION:**
Carts are optional. Players and caddies are allowed to ride in carts (drivers have to be at least 16 years of age or older, if club policy dictates). Spectators are not allowed in carts at any time. There will be a maximum of 2 carts per group and 2 bags per cart. Cart rental fee: \$24 per cart (player's responsibility – payable in the golf shop).
7. **PULL CARTS:**
 - * Pull carts are permitted.
 - * Rental Fee: \$5
8. **CADDIES:** Player may bring caddie.
9. **PLAYER CODE OF CONDUCT:**
By submitting an entry for any SCGA-administered competition, the contestant understands that his/her participation is at the sole discretion of the SCGA. A contestant may be removed from any competition at the discretion of the SCGA staff or Rules and Competitions Committee at any time before or during the competition. Incidents of unbecoming conduct or actions deemed to be detrimental to the image of the SCGA or the "Spirit of the Game" are grounds for such removal and suspension from future SCGA-administered competitions. These include, but are not limited to the following:
 - 1) Willful damage of the golf course or golf course property
 - 2) Club throwing or unnecessary club tossing
 - 3) Offensive or unbecoming language

4) Public criticism of golf course or verbal abuse of SCGA staff, officials, volunteers, host club staff or other contestants

5) Potential endangerment of others

6) Conduct deemed unbecoming

10. ATTIRE:

PLAYERS, CADDIES and SPECTATORS must be properly attired in golf shirts, slacks or (Bermuda-length dress shorts) and "spikeless" shoes. Jeans (any color or any kind), sweatpants, T-shirts and tank tops will not be permitted during any phase of the competition. Under no circumstances will this attire prohibition be waived for players. Shirts must be tucked in and hats are to be worn forward at all times.
ALL CLOTHING MUST BE IN GOOD REPAIR.

11. CANCELLATIONS:

To withdraw for any reason prior to the start of an SCGA competition, a player must notify the SCGA Rules and Competitions Department at (818) 432-4169. Failure to notify the SCGA will subject the player to suspension from future SCGA competitions. A player who only contacts the course and not the SCGA will be subject to the suspension.

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. PRACTICE ROUNDS:

*Players may make arrangements for practice rounds at their own expense.

*Players must call the Cottonwood Golf Shop to arrange a time to play - (619) 442-9891.

*Fee: Regular rates apply: \$35 to walk Monday – Friday

*Cart Fee: \$12

2. DRIVING RANGE:

*Driving range opens at 6:00 a.m. Balls will be available at the driving range.

*Fee: Compliments of the SCGA.

3. LOCKER ROOM:

*There will be no locker room available. Players are advised to come dressed and ready to play.

4. FOOD SERVICE:

*The Restaurant will be open from 6:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m.

***The SCGA will be hosting a player's lunch on Monday, July 9, immediately following the conclusion of your round.**

5. CASH PURCHASES:

*Cash will be accepted.

*Reciprocal chits will **NOT** be accepted.
