PGA OF SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GOLF CLUB (Legends Course)
TUESDAY – WEDNESDAY, NOVEMBER 27 – 28, 2007

PLEASE NOTE: WE ARE REQUESTING THAT YOU BRING THIS INFORMATION SHEET TO THE SITE WITH YOU ON THE DAY OF THE EVENT.

CONDITIONS OF THE COMPETITION

1. **COURSES:** The Net Division will play the Legends Course each day.
2. **STARTING TIMES:** Due to the layout and configuration of holes on the Legends Course, play will begin at 7:30 a.m. each day off of the 1st Tee ONLY. Tee times will range from 7:30 a.m. until approximately 10:30 a.m. Please check in with the starter at your assigned tee at least five to seven minutes in advance of your starting time. The starters will have information to discuss and distribute to each player in the group. Starters will not page players. Pairings for the final round will be based on the scores from the first round of play (leaders last). The pairings will be available approximately 1 hour after the conclusion of play on Tuesday.
3. **TEES:** Net Division (Legends Course) will play the Blue tees (White yardages will be used on Holes #5 and 11) 70.5 / 127 / 6,291.
4. **FORMAT:** 36-hole, Four-Ball Net Stroke Play – 18 Holes played each day. Each individual will play to 90% (men) and 95% (women) of their course handicap. The lowest index of the last three months (Sept. – Nov.) will be used to determine players' course handicaps. If partners' course handicaps differ by more than 8 strokes, an additional 10% reduction will be applied to their course handicaps. There will be two Championships played concurrently – a Gross and Net Division of the Senior Four-Ball Championship. The two divisions are not related and your team's score will only count in the division you have chosen to play in.
5. **RECORDING SCORES:** In Four-Ball competitions, only one partner must hole out. A partner who starts but does not complete a hole **must** record on the scorecard, for handicap purposes, the most likely score. The most likely score may not exceed the player's Equitable Stroke Control limit. This most likely score should be preceded by an "X" on the scorecard. Most likely score is a judgment that each player must make based on the player's own game. It consists of the number of strokes already taken plus, in the player's best judgment, the number of strokes needed to complete the hole from that position more than half the time. The player must evaluate each situation based on what the player can reasonable expect to score.
6. **RULES OF PLAY:**
 - *Play is governed by the USGA Rules of Golf.
 - *Local Rules in effect will be found on the enclosed SCGA Rules Hard Card and the Local Rules Addendum distributed at the site. Disregard all other club posted local rules.
 - *The "**one-ball**" rule will NOT be in effect.
 - *Shoes with traditionally-designed spikes (regardless of composition, i.e., ceramic, plastic, etc.), regardless of design, comprised either entirely or partially of metal (when such metal comes in contact with the surface of the course) are prohibited. Penalty for breach of this condition: DISQUALIFICATION.
 - ***Distance measuring devices are permitted.**
 - *The use of cell phones will NOT be permitted during the round or in the clubhouse.
7. **TIES:** Awards will be given to the top 5 finishing teams. In the event of a tie for 1st place only, there will be a sudden death playoff immediately following the conclusion of play.
8. **AUTOMOTIVE TRANSPORTATION:**

All players will be provided with golf carts as part of your entry fee. Spectators are not allowed in carts at any time. There will be a maximum of 2 carts per group and 2 bags per cart.
9. **PULL CARTS:** Pull carts are NOT permitted.
10. **CADDIES:** Players may bring a caddie. However, there will only be two carts per group allowed on the course.
11. **ATTIRE:** PLAYERS, CADDIES and SPECTATORS must be properly attired in golf shirts, slacks, appropriate shorts and "spikeless" shoes. Jeans (any color or any kind), sweatpants, T-shirts and tank tops will not be permitted on the property. Shirts must be tucked in and caps must be worn forward at all times. Under no circumstances will this attire prohibition be waived. ALL CLOTHING MUST BE IN GOOD REPAIR.

12. PLAYER CODE OF CONDUCT:

By submitting an entry for any SCGA-administered competition, the contestant understands that his/her participation is at the sole discretion of the SCGA. A contestant may be removed from any competition at the discretion of the SCGA staff or Rules and Competitions Committee at any time before or during the competition. Incidents of unbecoming conduct or actions deemed to be detrimental to the image of the SCGA or the "Spirit of the Game" are grounds for such removal and suspension from future SCGA-administered competitions. These include, but are not limited to the following:

- 1) Willful damage of the golf course or golf course property
- 2) Club throwing or unnecessary club tossing
- 3) Offensive or unbecoming language
- 4) Public criticism of golf course or verbal abuse of SCGA staff, officials, volunteers, host club staff or other contestants
- 5) Potential endangerment of others
- 6) Conduct deemed unbecoming

13. CANCELLATIONS :

To withdraw for any reason prior to the start of an SCGA competition, a player must notify the SCGA Rules and Competitions Department at (818) 432-4169. Failure to notify the SCGA will subject the player to suspension from future SCGA competitions. A player who only contacts the course and not the SCGA will be subject to the suspension. If you plan to withdraw please contact the SCGA office as soon as possible so an alternate can be contacted to play.

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. REGISTRATION: All players must check in at the SCGA registration table located next to the bag drop in the parking lot upon arrival on Monday.

2. PRACTICE ROUNDS: Players may contact the SCPGA Golf Shop up to 7 days in advance to arrange a practice round.
*Players should identify themselves as a participant in the SCGA Senior Four-Ball Championship.
*Fee: A Senior rate will be offered to all participants in the Championship: \$40 on weekdays: \$40 on weekends after 11 a.m. Regular rates apply at other times.

3. DRIVING RANGE: The driving range will open at 6:30 am.
*Complimentary range balls will be available on the driving range.

4. LOCKER ROOM: Locker Room service will not be available – players are advised to come dressed and ready to play.

5. FOOD SERVICE: The Restaurant / Grill will be open at 6:30 a.m. each day. There is also a snack bar located on the lower level of the clubhouse and a "halfway house" on the Legends course for additional food and beverage purchases. A stationary beverage cart will be situated on the golf course as well.
*The SCGA will host a small BBQ lunch immediately following the conclusion of play on Tuesday.

6. CASH PURCHASES:
* Cash will be accepted.
* Major credit cards will be accepted.
*Reciprocal Chits will not be accepted.
