**CONDITIONS OF THE COMPETITION**

1. **STARTING TIMES:** Please check in with the starter at your assigned tee at least five to seven minutes in advance of your tee time. The starters will have information to discuss and distribute to each player in the group. Starters will not page players.
2. **TEES:** Play will be from the **WHITE** tee markers.  
(70.6 / 129 / 6,215 yards)
3. **FORMAT:** 18-hole qualifying round. The field is divided into four flights based on your lowest index of the last three months: President (7.4 and below), Vice-President (7.5-12.4), Secretary (12.5-18.4) and Treasurer (18.5 and above). All players will play to their lowest index of the last three months. Qualifiers from the President and Secretary Flights advance to the SCGA Amateur Net Championship at Sycuan Resort (Willow Glen Course) on Monday - Tuesday, July 9 - 10, 2007. Qualifiers from the Vice President and Treasurer Flights advance to the SCGA Amateur Net Championship at Cottonwood Golf Club (Ivanhoe Course) on Monday - Tuesday, July 9 - 10, 2007. Final number of qualifying spots will be available from the Committee on the day of play.
4. **RULES OF PLAY:**
  - ◆ Play is governed by the USGA Rules of Golf.
  - ◆ Local Rules in effect will be found on the enclosed SCGA Rules Hard Card and the Local Rules Addendum distributed at the site. Disregard all other club posted local rules.
  - ◆ The "one-ball" rule will NOT be in effect.
  - ◆ Shoes with traditionally-designed spikes (regardless of composition, i.e., ceramic, plastic, etc.), regardless of design, comprised either entirely or partially of metal (when such metal comes in contact with the surface of the course) are prohibited. Penalty for breach of this condition: DISQUALIFICATION.
  - ◆ **Distance measuring devices are permitted.**
  - ◆ The use of cell phones will NOT be permitted during the round.
5. **TIES:** In the event of a tie for the last qualifying place or an alternate's position, the USGA method of matching scorecards will be used to determine results using holes #10-18. (See Appendix I: Conditions of the Competition in the USGA Rules of Golf).
6. **AUTOMOTIVE TRANSPORTATION:**  
Carts are optional. Players and caddies are allowed to ride in carts (drivers have to be at least 16 years of age or older, if club policy dictates). Spectators are not allowed in carts at any time. There will be a maximum of 2 carts per group and 2 bags per cart. Cart rental fee: \$11 per player (player's responsibility).
7. **PULL CARTS:**
  - \* Pull carts are permitted.
  - \* Club does not rent pull carts.
8. **CADDIES:** Player may bring caddie.
9. **PLAYER CODE OF CONDUCT:**  
By submitting an entry for any SCGA-administered competition, the contestant understands that his/her participation is at the sole discretion of the SCGA. A contestant may be removed from any competition at the discretion of the SCGA staff or Rules and Competitions Committee at any time before or during the competition. Incidents of unbecoming conduct or actions deemed to be detrimental to the image of the SCGA or the "Spirit of the Game" are grounds for such removal and suspension from future SCGA-administered competitions. These include, but are not limited to the following:
  - 1) Willful damage of the golf course or golf course property
  - 2) Club throwing or unnecessary club tossing
  - 3) Offensive or unbecoming language

- 4) Public criticism of golf course or verbal abuse of SCGA staff, officials, volunteers, host club staff or other contestants
  - 5) Potential endangerment of others
  - 6) Conduct deemed unbecoming
10. ATTIRE:  
PLAYERS, CADDIES and SPECTATORS must be properly attired in golf shirts, slacks or (Bermuda-length dress shorts) and "spikeless" shoes. Jeans (any color or any kind), sweatpants, T-shirts and tank tops will not be permitted during any phase of the competition. Under no circumstances will this attire prohibition be waived for players. Hats are to be worn forward at all times.  
ALL CLOTHING MUST BE IN GOOD REPAIR.
11. CANCELLATIONS:  
To withdraw for any reason prior to the start of an SCGA competition, a player must notify the SCGA Rules and Competitions Department at (818) 432-4169. Failure to notify the SCGA will subject the player to suspension from future SCGA competitions. A player who only contacts the course and not the SCGA will be subject to the suspension.

1. PRACTICE ROUNDS:
  - \*Players may make arrangements for practice rounds at their own expense.
  - \*Players must call the Via Verde Golf Shop for availability in advance of the day they wish to play - (909) 599-8486.
  - \*Fee: A twilight rate of \$31 applies after 2 p.m. on Tuesdays – Fridays.
  - \**Regular Rates apply at all other times.*
  
  - \*Cart Fee: Included in practice round green fee.
2. DRIVING RANGE:
  - \*Driving range opens at 6:30 a.m. Balls will be available for purchase in the golf shop.
  - \*Fee: \$4 – small; \$7 – large.
3. LOCKER ROOM:
  - \*The locker room will be available upon arrival. Players are NOT required to change shoes in the locker room.
4. FOOD SERVICE:
  - \* The Snack Bar will be open from 7:30 a.m. until the conclusion of play. The Snack Bar is located near the 9<sup>th</sup> green on the back side of the club house.
5. CASH PURCHASES:
  - \* Cash will **NOT** be accepted.
  - \* Reciprocal chits will be accepted.
  - \* MasterCard and Visa will be accepted.
