

**96TH ANNUAL CALIFORNIA GOLF ASSOCIATION AMATEUR
CHAMPIONSHIP**

(CALIFORNIA STATE AMATEUR)

**MONTEREY PENINSULA COUNTRY CLUB – DUNES AND SHORE COURSES
JUNE 18-23, 2007**

FORMAT: **Monday June 18th** – 18 holes of stroke play on Dunes and Shore courses with 78 players per course starting at 7:30 AM in groups of three off tee number one.

Tuesday June 19th – 18 holes of stroke play on the Dunes and Shore Courses with 78 players per course starting at 7:30 AM groups of three off tee number one.

**PLAY OFF: IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING PLAY A PLAY OFF
WILL TAKE PLACE FOR THE 32ND SPOT**

Wednesday June 20th - first round of match play will take place on the Shore Course with 32 players starting at 7:30 AM in groups of two off tee number one.

Thursday June 21st - second round of match play will take place on the Shore Course with 16 players starting at 7:30 AM in groups of two off tee number one.

Friday June 22nd - quarter finals of match play will take place on the Shore Course with eight players starting at 7:30 AM in groups of two off tee number one.

Friday June 22nd - semi finals of match play will take place on the Shore Course with four players starting at 1:00 PM in groups of two off tee number one.

Saturday June 23rd - 36 hole finals of match play will take place on the Shore Course starting at 7:30 AM and 12:30 PM.

NORTH/SOUTH MATCHES: The North/South Challenge Matches are a two day competition between the Southern California Golf Association and the Northern California Golf Association which take place during stroke play qualifying on Monday and Tuesday. The winning team will hold the rights to the Roger Lampham Trophy. Each team is selected by their respective association. The final results are based on the best five scores out of six for each of the teams for a two day total score.

ENTRY FEE: The championship entry fee is \$200. If you entered qualifying using your credit card through the online registration system your card is automatically charged the additional \$200. Those players that entered by paper entry will be sent a qualifying certificate to return with an additional \$200. In addition to the tournament rounds the entry fee includes one practice round, breakfast and lunch each day and range balls. All exempt players have already been charged the \$200 entry fee and will not be charged any additional fees.

REGISTRATION: REGISTRATION IS REQUIRED FOR ALL CONTESTANTS.

The location will be at the Caddy Shack located between the lower parking lot and the first tee on the Dunes Course. The hours of registration will be Sunday June 17th between the hours of 12 noon and 3:30 PM and Monday June 18th starting at 6:30 AM. It is very important that you register prior to your first scheduled starting time on Monday. Registration will provide you with last minute important information. Since MPCC is a no cash facility a player ID card will be given to you that will enable you to receive breakfast and lunch and give you the opportunity to purchase any needed golf balls, gloves etc. or rent carts from the proshop.

DRESS: VERY IMPORTANT – Contestants, caddies and spectators must be properly attired on the grounds and buildings of the Monterey Peninsula Country Club. Blue jeans, T-shirts or tank tops are prohibited. **SHORTS ARE NOT ALLOWED ON PROPERTY FOR THE PLAYERS, CADDIES OR SPECTATORS. HATS MUST BE REMOVED WHEN ENTERING ANY OF THE CLUBHOUSE FACILITIES.**

A player or caddie violating this dress code will not be permitted to start the competition. If during play the dress code is violated by either the player or his caddie the violation must be rectified without undue delay or the player will not continue to play and the caddie will not be allowed to perform the acts of a caddie. Spectators in violation will be asked to rectify their situation as well or will have to leave the property.

MPCC is a non metal spike facility.

PRACTICE ROUNDS – CONTESTANTS ONLY: Monterey Peninsula Country Club will host one practice round on Sunday June 17th beginning at 1:00 PM on both courses. This is the only time that practice rounds are available. In order to be fair to all participants' calls for a practice round will not be accepted until **Wednesday, May 30th starting at 8:30 AM – DO NOT CALL MPCC or the SCGA.** You must contact the **Northern California Golf Association** at 1-800-325-6234 for a tee time. Reservations will be on a first come first serve basis and must be made by Thursday June 14th before 5 PM. The field will be divided equally on both courses for both NCGA and SCGA players.

NOTE: Food and beverage will not be available for Sunday's practice round. The shelters will be closed therefore it is suggested that you bring and carry your own food and beverage needs.

DRIVING RANGE: The driving range will be available every day in the AM prior to your assigned tee time. However the range will not be available after your rounds in the PM. The practice chipping and putting areas will be available to use in the PM as well as the Poppy Hills driving range.

TRANSPORTATION: Automotive transportation is permitted during the Championship for players and their caddies only. **SPECTATOR CARTS ARE PROHIBITED.**

Carts are restricted to the cart paths only on the Dunes Course. **Carts are being discouraged from being used on the Shore Course due to the lack of cart paths and the restriction of carts from being driven off the fairways and into the restricted native grassy areas.**

Cart rental is \$20 per player per round.

Pull carts are permitted on both courses and must remain off the collars surrounding the putting greens. MPCC does not have pull carts to offer.

PACE OF PLAY: It is important to understand that the NCGA/USGA check point pace of play policy will be in effect. All groups will need to be on time at each check point or they will be subject to penalty. The policy itself will be handed out at registration and their will be an official on the practice putting green on Monday the first round of stroke play to answer questions and review the policy.

FOOD AND BEVERAGE: A hosted breakfast (6:30 – 11:00 AM) and lunch (11:30 AM – 4:00 PM) Monday through Wednesday for contestants only in the main dining room. Contestants moving onto the second round of match play will be able to order breakfast and lunch from The Grill menu in the main clubhouse. Spectators and caddies will have access to food and beverage at the shelters on both courses Monday and Tuesday and the Shore Course only Wednesday through Saturday. MPCC is a non cash

club and therefore cannot accept cash, checks, credit cards or reciprocal charges. Spectators will be able to purchase script at the shelters for food and beverage from a limited menu.

CELL PHONES: The use of cell phones is only permitted in the parking lots.

PARKING: Parking will be available in the lower lot only which is located at the first left as you come up the main entrance and will be marked accordingly. **DO NOT PARK IN THE MEMBER LOTS SURROUNDING THE MAIN BUILDINGS.**

17 MILE DRIVE ENTRANCE: You only need to identify yourself as a contestant participating in the championship being played at Monterey Peninsula Country Club when entering the forest at any of the five gates. This will include Sunday June 17th for the practice round.
