Simi Hills Golf Course and Lost Canyons Golf Club to Host City Four-Ball Championship

Simi Valley, CA – **Lost Canyons Golf Club** and **Simi Hills Golf Course** will co-host the Simi Valley City Four-Ball Championship on Saturday and Sunday, May 30 and 31, 2009. After a very successful inaugural event in 2008, a number of enhancements are in place to make the match even more exciting for participants. The 2009 event will have a championship gross flight and a number of net flights. In addition, there will be closest to the pin contests on each day and second-day prizes for teams who finish in the bottom third of entrants on the first day.

The two-player teams can work around bad shots and take advantage of great holes as well.
