Beyond the championship courses, Streamsong continues to innovate with additions like The Chain, a short course designed for casual, fast-paced play, and The Gauntlet, a putting course that adds a fun twist to the traditional golf experience. STREAMSONG RED

Streamsong Red is a visually arresting and strategically rich golf course designed by the acclaimed duo Bill Coore and Ben Crenshaw. This 18-hole layout winds through a landscape of towering sand dunes, expansive lakes, and natural bunkers, all remnants of the site's former life as a phosphate mine. The terrain is unlike anything typically found in Florida, offering rolling contours and stretches of open savannah that challenge players to think creatively on every shot. Coore and Crenshaw, known for their minimalist approach and deep respect for natural landforms, have crafted a course that feels both timeless and adventurous, making Streamsong Red a must-play for serious golfers.

Adding a layer of historical intrigue, Streamsong Red features a locomotive logo that pays tribute to the site's industrial past. During mining operations, an 1880s-era steam engine was unearthed and now resides at the nearby Mulberry Phosphate Museum. This nod to history complements the course's modern acclaim, with Streamsong Red consistently ranked among the top public courses in the country—#21 on Golf Digest's 2023 list and #18 on Golfweek's 2024 Top 100 Courses You Can Play. The course's blend of natural beauty, strategic design, and historical resonance makes it a standout destination in the world of golf.



STREAMSONG BLUE

Designed by renowned architect Tom Doak of Renaissance Golf Design, Streamsong Blue is a visually stunning and strategically challenging golf course nestled in Central Florida. The terrain, shaped by a former phosphate mining site, offers dramatic elevation changes, undulating contours, and expansive fairways that weave through wild grasses, deep-water ponds, and massive bunkers cascading from towering sand dunes. The course feels more discovered than constructed, with each hole offering a unique blend of natural beauty and thoughtful design. This distinctive landscape sets Streamsong Blue apart from typical Florida courses, making it a standout destination for golf enthusiasts seeking a pure and immersive experience.

Beyond its captivating layout, Streamsong Blue has earned widespread acclaim, consistently ranking among the top public courses in the United States. It was named #26 on Golf Digest's 2025 list of America's 100 Greatest Public Courses and holds similar honors from Golfweek and GOLF Magazine. Adding a whimsical touch to its identity, the course features a Megalodon logo, paying homage to the prehistoric shark that once roamed the ancient seas covering the region. Players are even encouraged to keep an eye out for fossilized shark teeth in the native areas surrounding the course, adding a layer of discovery to an already unforgettable round.



STREAMSONG BLACK

Streamsong Black, designed by acclaimed architect Gil Hanse, is a bold and expansive Par-73 championship course that showcases the dramatic natural features of Central Florida's reclaimed mining terrain. The layout is characterized by sweeping elevation changes, rolling fairways, and rugged sand ridges reminiscent of Australia's famed Sand Belt region. Hanse's design embraces the scale and shape of the land, resulting in a course that is both visually stunning and strategically engaging. One of its standout features is "The Gauntlet," a 1.2-acre putting course located just outside the Black clubhouse, offering a fun and competitive way to warm up or wind down your round.

The course's logo—a stylized windmill—pays homage to the iconic aiming point on the ninth hole, where players are encouraged to "aim at the windmill" to find the fairway. Streamsong Black has quickly earned its place among the elite public courses in the U.S., ranking #33 on Golf Digest's 2025 list of America's 100 Greatest Public Courses and #31 on Golfweek's Top 100 Courses You Can Play. Its combination of scale, creativity, and natural beauty makes it a compelling complement to Streamsong Red and Blue, rounding out one of the most unique golf destinations in the country.
