Tom and Bill are playing a handicap match. Tom has a current Index of 3.2 while Bill's Index is 12.7.

- A. Tom has a Course Handicap of 3.  
Bill has a Course Handicap 14.  
Both are playing from the regular tees. (70.3 / 122)
  
- B. Per USGA Handicap System Section 9-4a(i), for Singles Match Play, because Tom is the lower-handicap player, he plays from scratch. Bill receives 11 strokes or "pops" on the first 11 allocated handicap-stroke holes (holes 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 9, 11, 13, 15, 17 & 18) because as the higher-handicapped player, he receives the full difference in their Course Handicaps (Bill's CH is 14 minus Tom's CH of 3)
